## What's Next? Lawsuits Against Businesses

- Opportunities for Lawsuits
  - Individuals diagnosed with COVID-19
  - Individuals exposed to COVID-19 who did not develop it
- Potential Targets & Claims
  - Businesses for exposing customers
  - Employers for work-related employee exposure
  - Manufacturers of products that protect against COVID-19
  - Healthcare providers

## What's Next? Lawsuits Against Healthcare Providers

- Patients who contract COVID-19 at doctor's office or hospital
- Healthcare workers who allege they lacked sufficient protective equipment
- Medical liability actions alleging a non-COVID-19 patient should have been admitted or was discharged too early
- Actions from treatment decisions stemming from lack of available equipment, such as ventilators

#### Potential Trial Lawyer Greed in Time of Need: How to Flatten the Curve

- Innovative trial lawyers will search for claims to bring on behalf of "victims" injured or potentially injured by COVID-19
  - Externalizing responsibility
- Challenges for COVID-19 Plaintiffs
  - Causation. Causation.
  - Comparative fault/assumption of risk
- Opportunities for Creative Claims
  - Loss of chance
  - Medical monitoring
  - No injury, fear of injury, and emotional harm
  - Failure to warn
- Challenges for COVID-19 Defendants
  - Pressure to settle surge of claims
  - Damage to reputation
